A \$1,000 scholarship award is available to an applicant that meets the following criteria:

- Be a Muscatine Community School District teacher pursuing a master's in education degree, with preference given to a master's in special education and/or a master's in gifted and talented.
- Preference given to educators intending to pursue a master's in education for classroom teaching.
- Preference given to educators that have a commitment to the Muscatine Community School District through past employment and intent to continue serving in the Muscatine Community School District.

This scholarship endowment has been established in honor of Marvin and Darlene to support Muscatine Community School District teachers furthering their education in an effort to better engage and manage their classrooms, improving educational outcomes for the students in our community.
